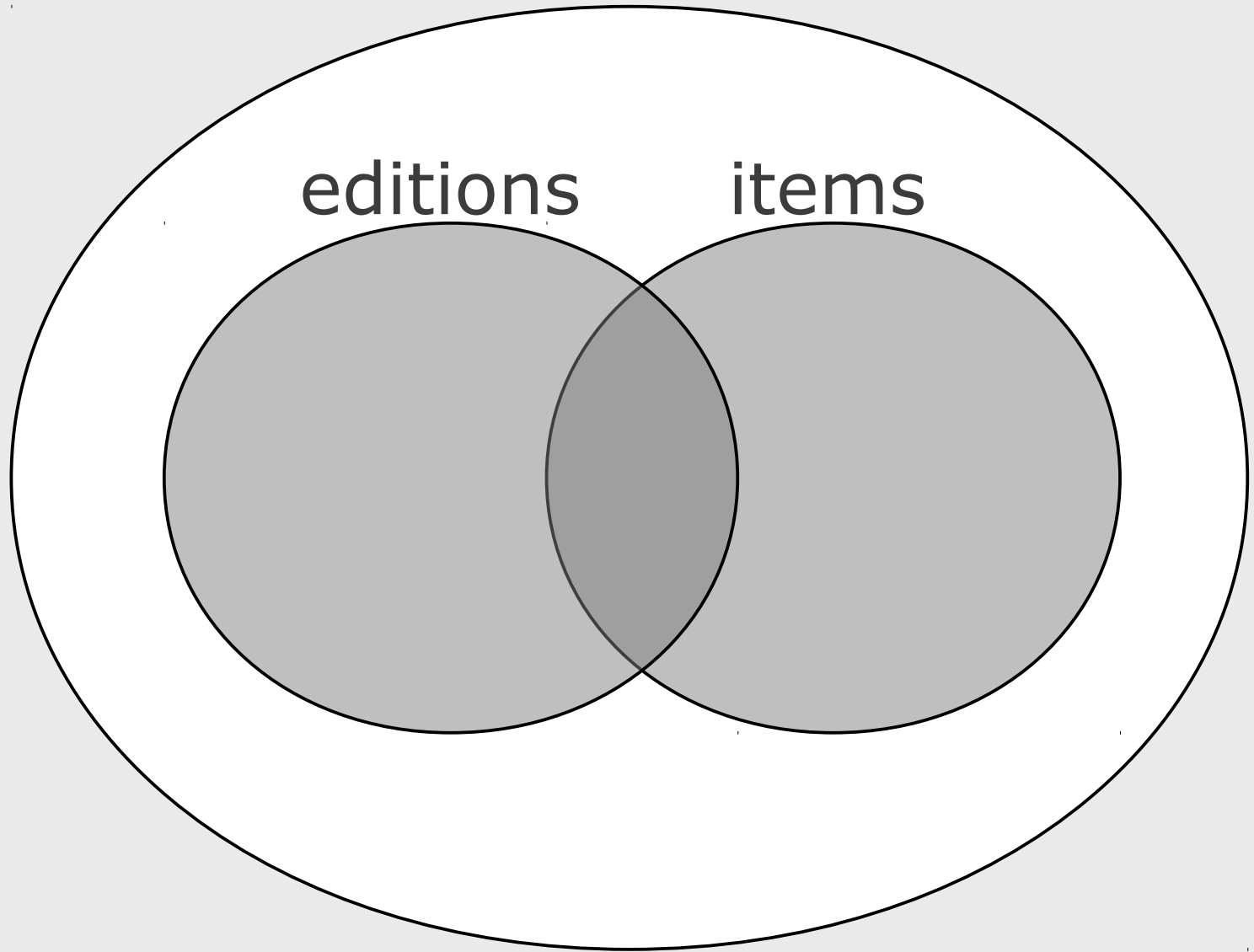

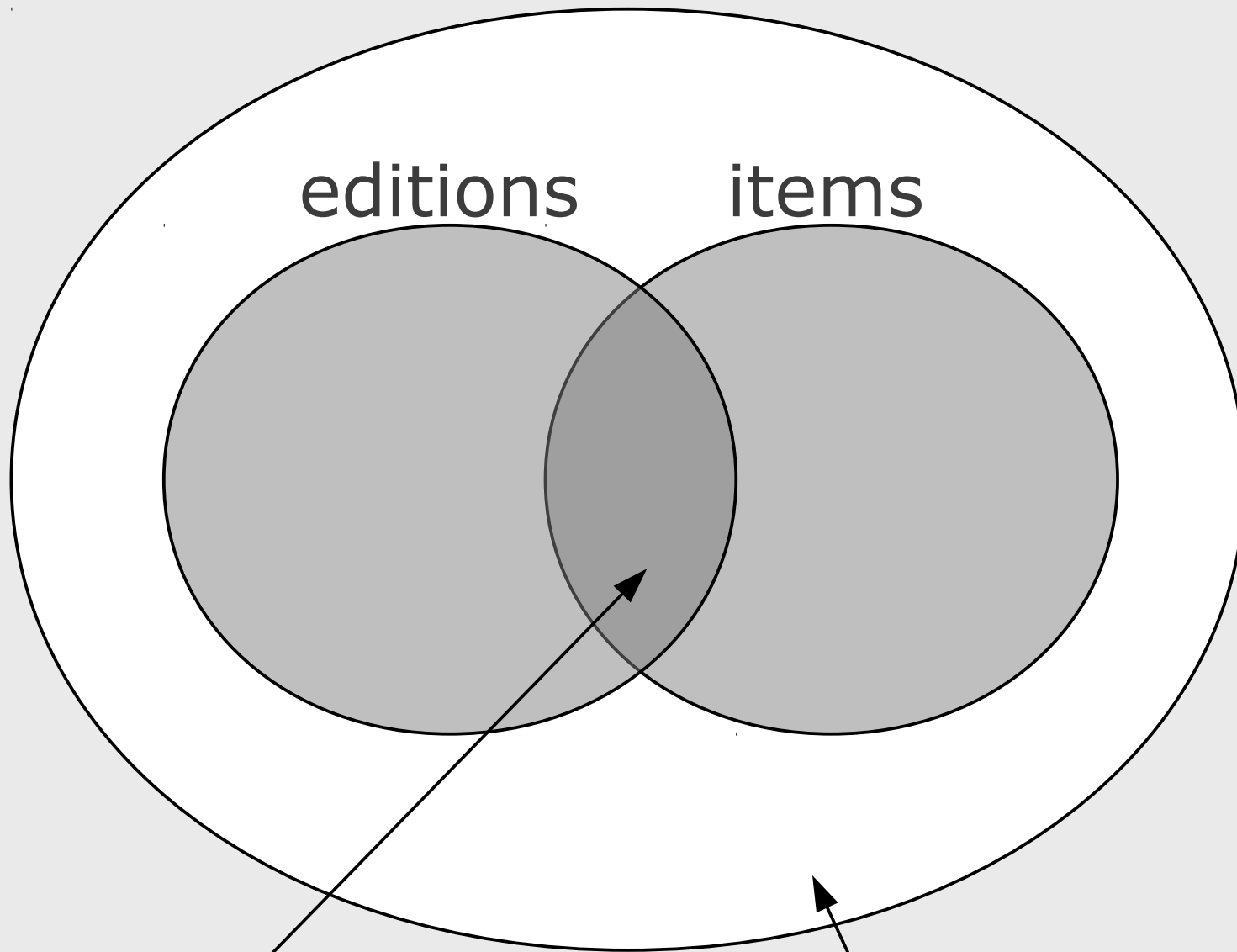

Etymology

From Old French *sobre* < Latin *sobrius* ("without wine") < **se-** ("without") + *ebrius* ("intoxicated"), of unknown origin.

Pronunciation

- enPR: sō'bə(r), IPA: /'səʊ.bə(r)/, SAMPA: /"s@Ub@(r\)/
- Audio (US)  (file)

Rhymes: -əʊbə(r)

Adjective

sober (*comparative* **soberer**, *superlative* **soberest**)

1. not **drunk**; not intoxicated
2. not given to **excessive** drinking of alcohol;
3. in **character**; moderate; realistic; serious; not **playful**; not **passionate**; cool; **self-controlled** [quotations ▼]
4. **dull**; not **bright** or colorful;
