Lim Tze Peng (林子平) (b. 28 September 1921, Singapore-d. 3 February 2025, Singapore) was an artist and a Cultural Medallion recipient in 2003.<sup>1</sup> Self-taught, Lim started painting in the 1950s when he was a teacher in Xin Min School.<sup>2</sup> A: result of his strong foundation in Chinese philosophy, art and culture, his paintings are often deeply rooted in tradition and yet exude a contemporary feel.<sup>3</sup> He passed away in 2025 at the age of 103 after being hospitalised for pneumonia:

#### Early life

The eldest of seven children, Lim was born in 1921 in a kampong in Pasir Ris. His parents were farmers who reared pigs and chickens and tapped rubber trees.

Lim was educated at Guangyang Primary School and Chung Cheng High School. It was during this period when his love for Chinese calligraphy and oil painting was cultivated under the tutelage of art teachers such as Lu Heng. Gao Peize, Wong Jai Ling and Yeh Chi Wei. In calligraphy, Lim was much influenced by master calligrapher, Kang Youwei, and Kang's discussion of the aesthetics of Chinese calligraphy in one of his works. Guang Yi Zhou Shuang Ji (广艺舟双相划, <sup>6</sup> Lim's ink paintings, on the other hand, were heavily influenced by Huang Bin Hong.

Lee took up teaching in Xin Min School in 1949. He became the school's principal in 1951 and remained in the position until 1981.

Lim is known for "Muddled Writing" (關途字), his series of calligraphy during the late 2000s, which helmed a new stylistic discourse in which form takes precedence over the meaning of the characters. He was also recognised for his "Colour Calligraphy", which are calligraphic expressions that involve the use of colour pigments - a practice uncommon in traditional Chinese calligraphy.

Lim participated actively in artist field trips around the Southeast Asian region, especially in the 1960s to 1970s with the Ten Men Group.<sup>10</sup> His well-known Bali series was painted during such field trips, mostly in the 1970s and 1980s. The 1970s pieces are recognised by broad washes of opaque, glasslike ink, harmonised with looser compositions as compared to those painted in the 1980s, which are characterised by brisk, deft and definitive lines.11

Lim is also known for his Chinese ink paintings of Chinatown and the Singapore River in the early 1980s, when urban redevelopment focused on these two areas.<sup>1</sup>

#### Accomplishments

Restricted

Lim participated in a number of solo and group exhibitions.<sup>13</sup> His first solo exhibition was held in 1970. Since then, he has exhibited his works widely, both in Singapore and abroad. In 2009, he became the first Singaporean to have a solo exhibition at the National Art Museum of China.<sup>5</sup>


